A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF PEACE RIVER IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
TO AMEND BYLAW NO.1426 (UNTIDY AND UNSIGHTLY PREMISES BYLAW)

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Peace River has enacted Bylaw 1426 being the Untidy and Unsightly Premises Bylaw for the Town, and;


WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Peace River has deemed it appropriate to amend Bylaw 1426;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of peace River in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:


1. That sub-section 3 (a) (i) be added to section 3:

3 (a) (i) All owners or occupants shall be required to cut the grass on any boulevard which abuts, flanks or adjoins the property occupied by him. This includes lanes or alleys at the rear or side of the premises.

READ a first and second time in Council this 13th day of June, A.D., 1994.




