

**TOWN OF PEACE RIVER  
BYLAW NO. 2019**

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF PEACE RIVER IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REPEAL BYLAW 2004 A BYLAW THAT AMENDED BYLAW NO. 1891.

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WHEREAS pursuant to Section 191(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26, of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and any amendments thereto, the Council is empowered to amend or repeal any Bylaw;

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Peace River has adopted Bylaw No. 1891, being the Land Use Bylaw, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Peace River deemed it advisable to amend the said Bylaw;

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Peace River passed Bylaw No. 2004 to rezone a parcel of land;

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Peace River deems it advisable to repeal said amendment;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Peace River, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. Repeal Bylaw No. 2004, which rezoned that portion of NE-36-83-22-5 from Residential-2 District (R-2) to Residential Manufactured (Mobile) Home Subdivision District (R-MHS) as shown in Schedule A.

**SEVERABILITY**

2. If any portion of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion shall be severed.
