

**TOWN OF PEACE RIVER  
BYLAW NO. 2037**

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF PEACE RIVER IN THE PROVINCE OF  
ALBERTA TO AMEND BYLAW 1912

---

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act* Section 146(b), the Council has the authority to establish a Sport, Recreation, and Cultural Board for the encouragement and development of recreation programs, services and facilities;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Peace River has given third reading to Bylaw #1912;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Peace River deems it advisable to amend Bylaw #1912;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Peace River, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Remove Section 3(b)2 and replace with a new Section 3(b)2 to read;

*"An individual of Indigenous heritage;"*

2. Remove Section Terms of office section 4.(a)(2) and 4.(a)(3) and replace with a new Section to read;

*"The remaining members of the Board shall be appointed for a 3-year term. With option for reappointment of an additional 1-year term from the original date of Council's appointment to a maximum of four consecutive years."*

**EFFECTIVE DATE**


4. This Bylaw shall come into force and have effect on the date of third and final reading.

READ a first time this 11 day of June, 2018.

READ a second time this 11 day of June, 2018.

READ a third and final time this 11 day of June, 2018.
