

**TOWN OF PEACE RIVER  
REVISED BYLAW NO. 2049**

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF PEACE RIVER IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REPEAL BYLAWS 1929 AND BYLAW 1952 THAT AMENDED BYLAW 1851

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WHEREAS pursuant to Section 63(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26, of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and any amendments thereto, the Council may by Bylaw, omit and provide for the repeal of a Bylaw or a provision of a Bylaw that is inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective; and

WHEREAS Bylaws 1929 and 1952 amend Bylaw 1851; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Peace River has repealed Bylaw 1851;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Peace River, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Repeal Bylaw 1929, a Bylaw to amend 1851, the Off-Site Levy Bylaw, and any amendments thereto; and
2. Repeal Bylaw 1952, a Bylaw to amend 1851, the Off-Site Levy Bylaw, and any amendments thereto.

TITLE

3. This bylaw may be cited as the "Bylaw to Repeal Bylaws 1929 and 1952".

SEVERABILITY

4. If any portion of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion shall be severed.

EFFECTIVE DATE


5. This Bylaw shall come into force and have effect on the date of third and final reading.


