

TAXI PASS PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Taxi Pass Program subsidizes the cost of taking a Taxi for eligible residents of Peace River. Program information and applications are online: www.peaceriver.ca/taxi or call (780)624-1000 for more information.

Clients applying for the Taxi Pass Program must also submit a completed application and Proof of Residency.

LOW INCOME REFERRAL

This form can be used as Income Verification for clients who are unable to provide either their Notice of Assessment or Income Tax Summary for the current tax year, or if the client's income situation has changed since they filed their taxes. Clients who are applying under another category, such as Seniors, AISH clients, or Students should not use the Low Income Agency Referral, they should submit the documents listed on the application.

Low Income – Individual – An individual who does not live with a partner or minor children and whose annual income is \$15,000 or less per year.

Low Income – Family – A family is either a single adult with minor children, or two adult partners with or without children. The total combined family income in a two-partner family must be \$25,000 or less per year.

REFERRALS CAN ONLY COME FROM A SOCIAL SUPPORT AGENCY. A Social Support Agency is a non-profit agency that provides basic supports such as financial assistance, affordable housing, crisis intervention, brain injury, developmental disabilities, social work, addictions, mental health, etc. **Examples: Alberta Works, Women's Shelter, Sagitawa Friendship Centre, Food Bank, etc.**

A referral **cannot** come from a family member, a friend, employer, or coworker.
