The Snow Angels Program connects volunteers who are willing to shovel sidewalks with residents who are unable to shovel for themselves. The program is open to seniors age 65 and older, or individuals with disabilities. All program participants will receive a yard sign to let their neighbours know they could use a hand. The program also recruits volunteers who would like to help, and pairs them with people in need. The program's goal is to serve all seniors and people with disabilities who apply, however, priority is given to those with less social support and resources.
