

**TOWN OF PEACE RIVER
BYLAW NO. 2103**

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF PEACE RIVER IN THE PROVINCE OF
ALBERTA TO REPEAL 2076 FACE COVERINGS BYLAW

WHEREAS Bylaw 2076 establishes activating conditions for the requiring of the wearing of face coverings in public places within the Town of Peace River; and

WHEREAS these activating conditions were based on the Province's relaunch status conditions as established at that time; and

WHEREAS these status conditions are no longer in use by the Province; and

WHEREAS the activating conditions under the Bylaw which require the wearing of face coverings in public places cannot thus be met; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Peace River finds it desirable therefore to repeal Bylaw No. 2076 the Face Coverings Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Peace River, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

TITLE

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Bylaw to Repeal Bylaw 2076".

REPEAL

2. Bylaw 2076 and its amendments, as amended, are hereby repealed.

EFFECTIVE DATE

3. This Bylaw shall come into force and have effect on the date of third and final reading.

READ a first time this 14 day of June, 2021.

READ a second time this 14 day of June, 2021.

READ a third and final time this 14 day of June, 2021.
