We are honoring our current fee bylaw. However, it is under review and will change with notice provided.

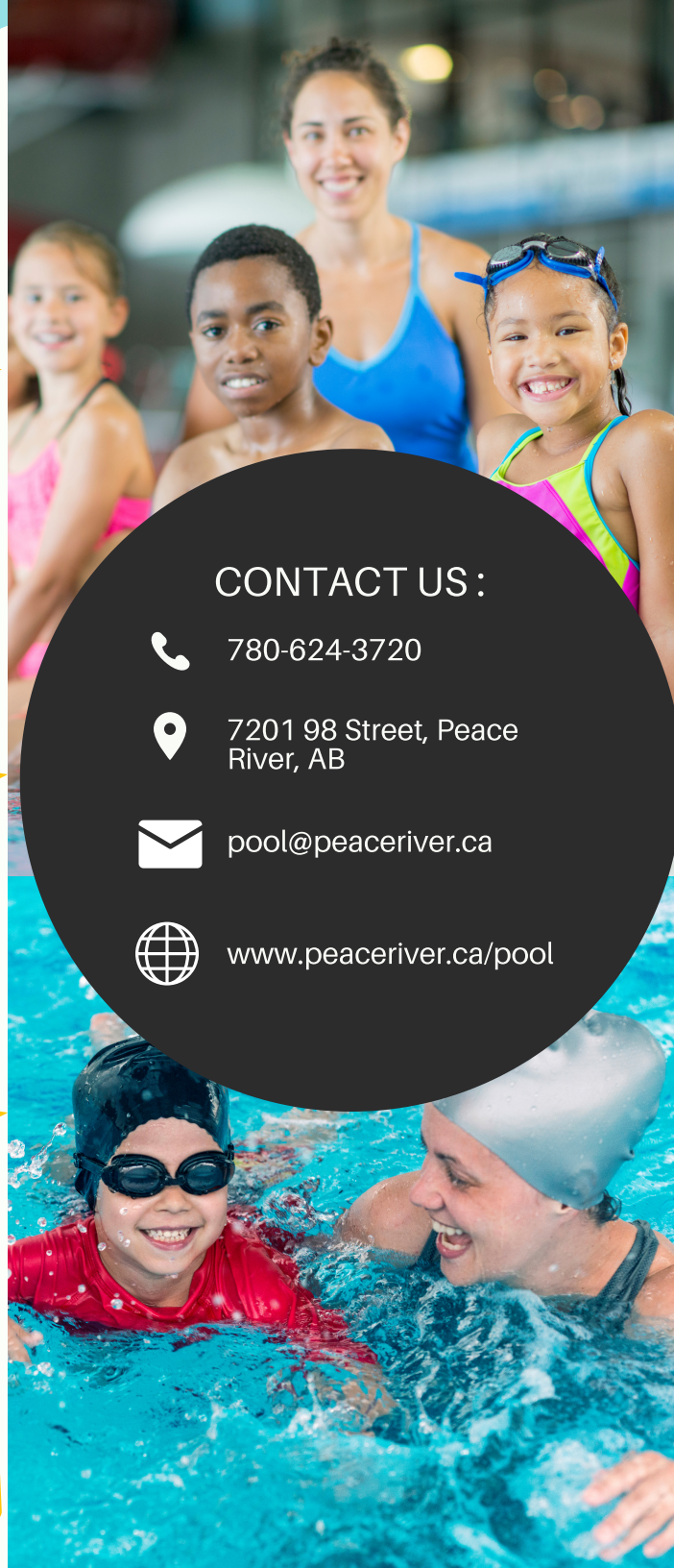
My child was in Level 8, but the chart says to put them into Swimmer 6 - why did they move backwards?

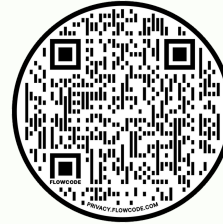
